

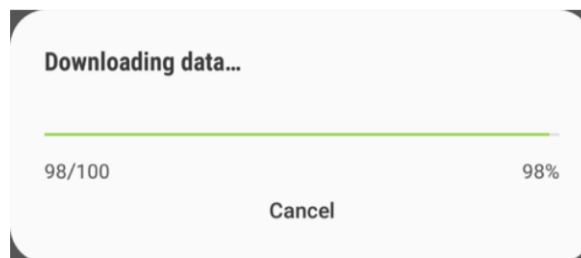
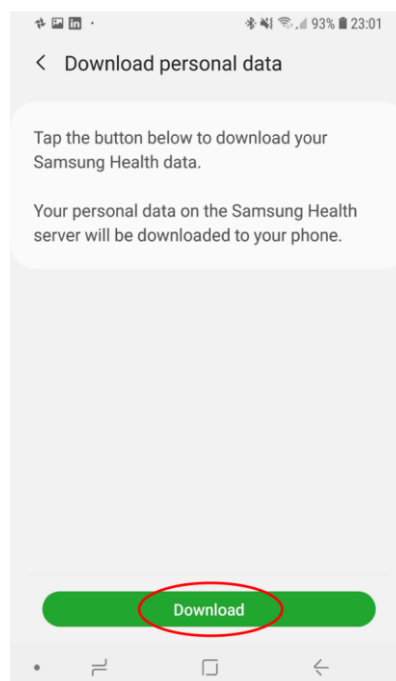

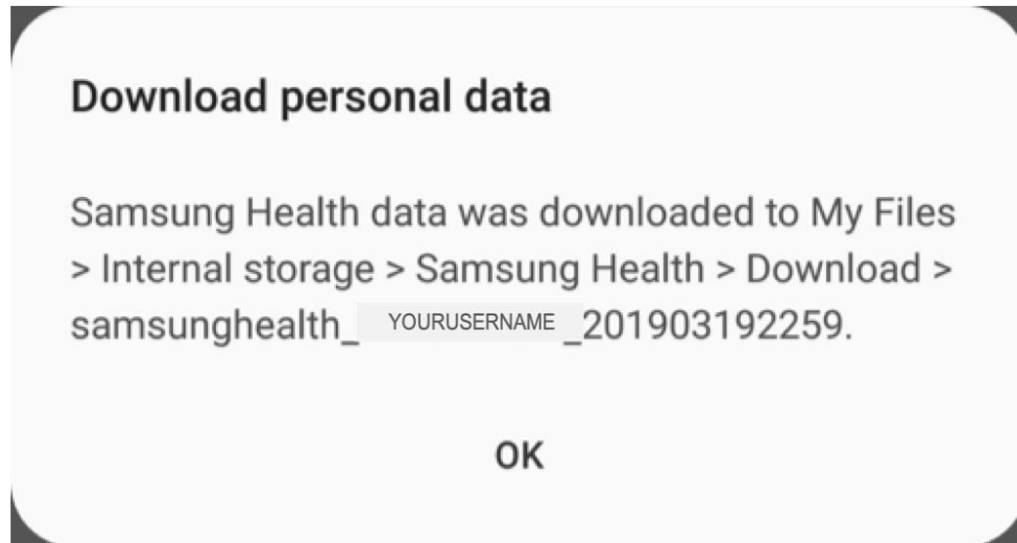
Export process:

1. From the Samsung Health app main screen on your phone, tap the **3 dots icon** in the top right.
2. Tap the **Settings** option.
3. Scroll down to the **Data** section and tap **Download personal data**.
4. Tap **Download**.



5. When complete, it tells you where it was downloaded to. It will probably be in **My Files > Internal storage > Samsung Health > Download > samsunghealth_<YOUR USER NAME>_201901032259**.

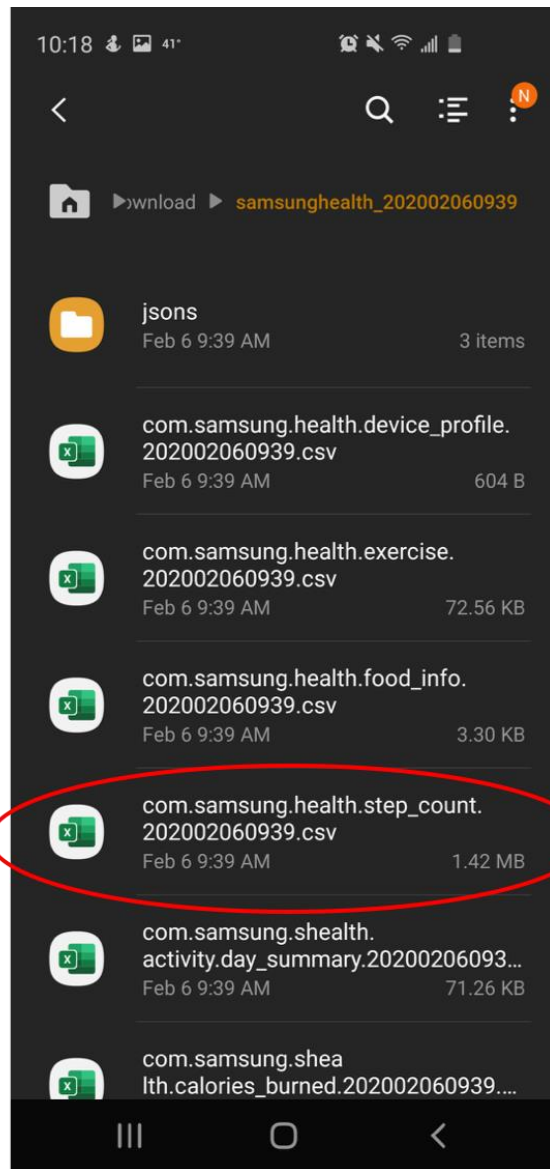

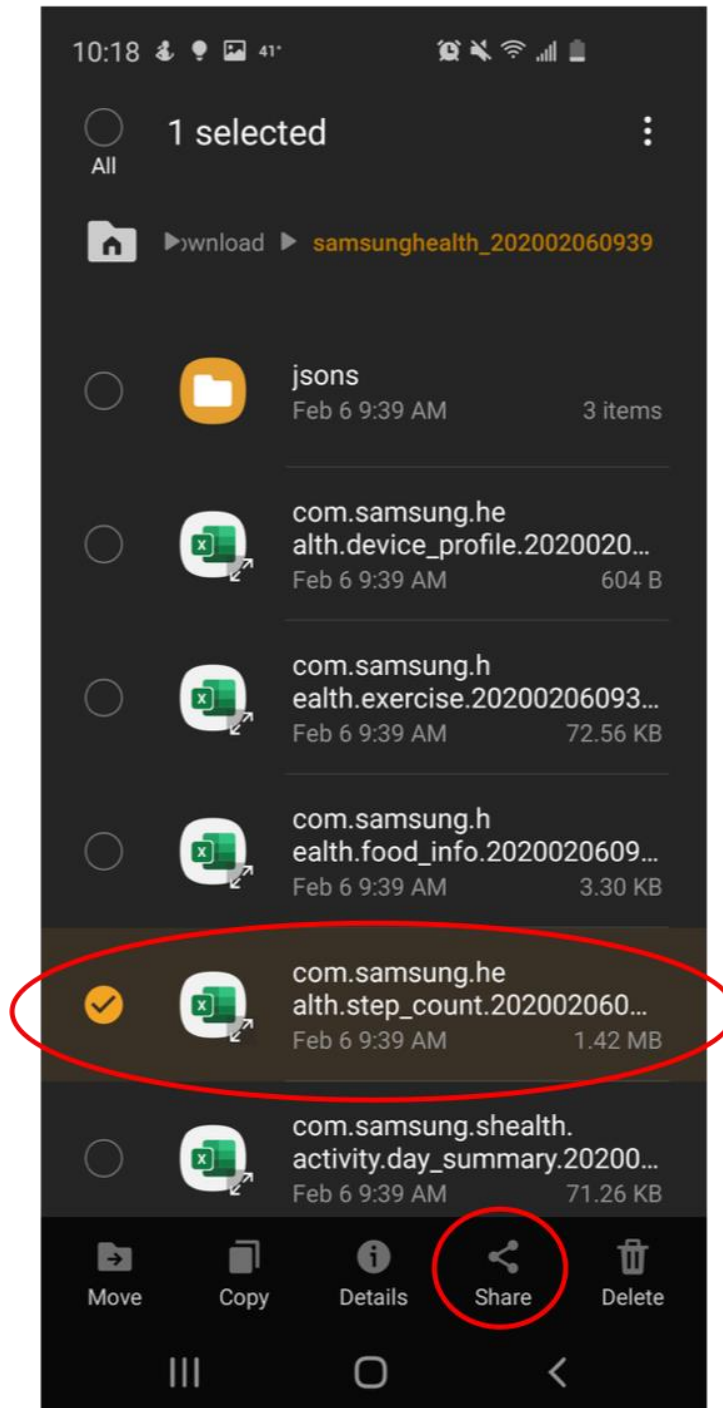
6. Use the **My Files** app to browse to that location. **My Files > Internal storage > Samsung Health > Download > samsunghealth_yourusername>201903192259** (or some other unique number sequence).

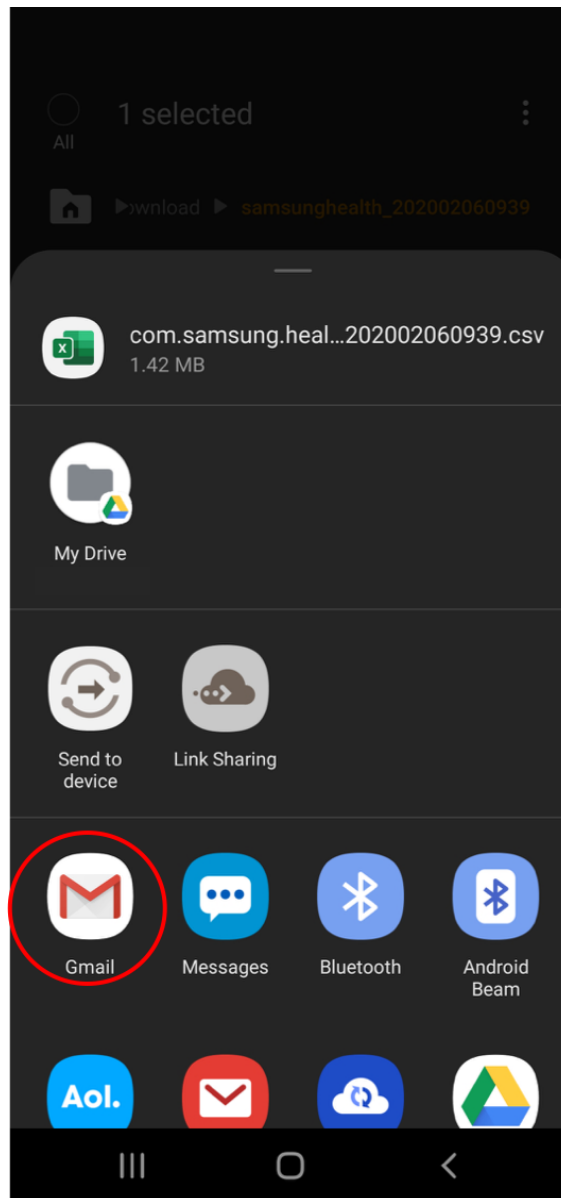
7. Select the **samsunghealth_yourusername>201903192259** (or some other unique number sequence) folder and scroll down to find a file labeled **com.samsung.health.step_count.202002060939.csv** (or some other unique number sequence)



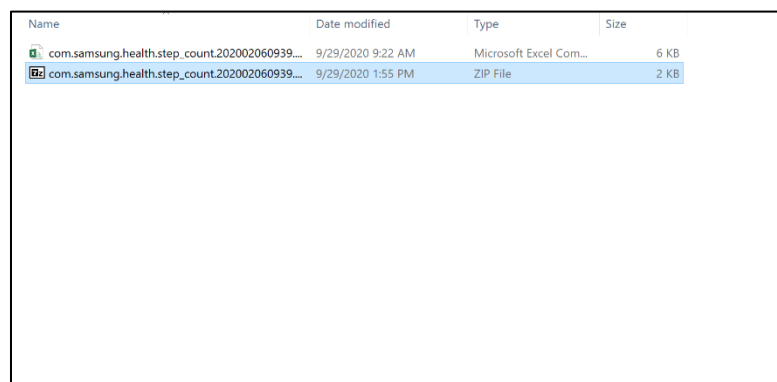
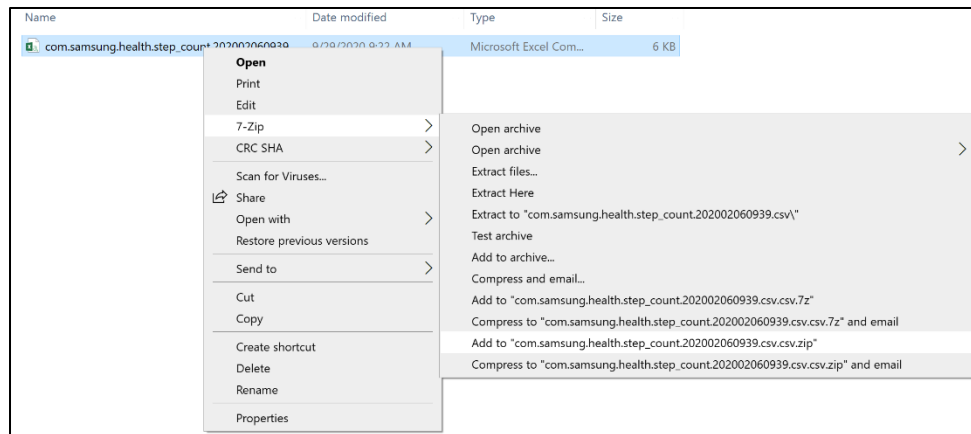
8. Hold down the **com.samsung.health.step_count.202002060939.csv** (or some other unique number sequence) file with a finger and you will see a checkbox appear to the left of it. Ensure only this file is selected and click the Share icon at the bottom of the screen.



9. Select **Gmail** (or other preferred Mail app) from the sharing options and email the .csv file to yourself.





10. Open the email on a computer and download the **com.samsung.health.step_count.202002060939.csv** file.
11. Navigate to the file in your Downloads folder. Right click on the file and compress to create a .zip file.



12. Return to the Center for Digital Health Donate Your Data webpage (the link in the email that you received from our research team; it should look similar to: <https://donate.centerfordigitalhealth.upenn.edu/socialshare?activity=<number>&survey=<number>>)
13. Click **Upload Data** next to the Google icon.

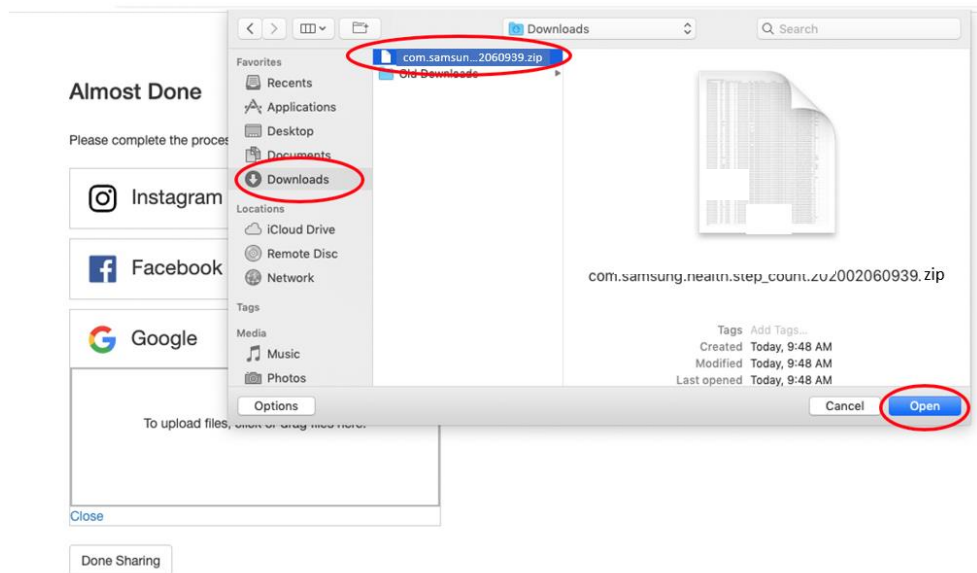

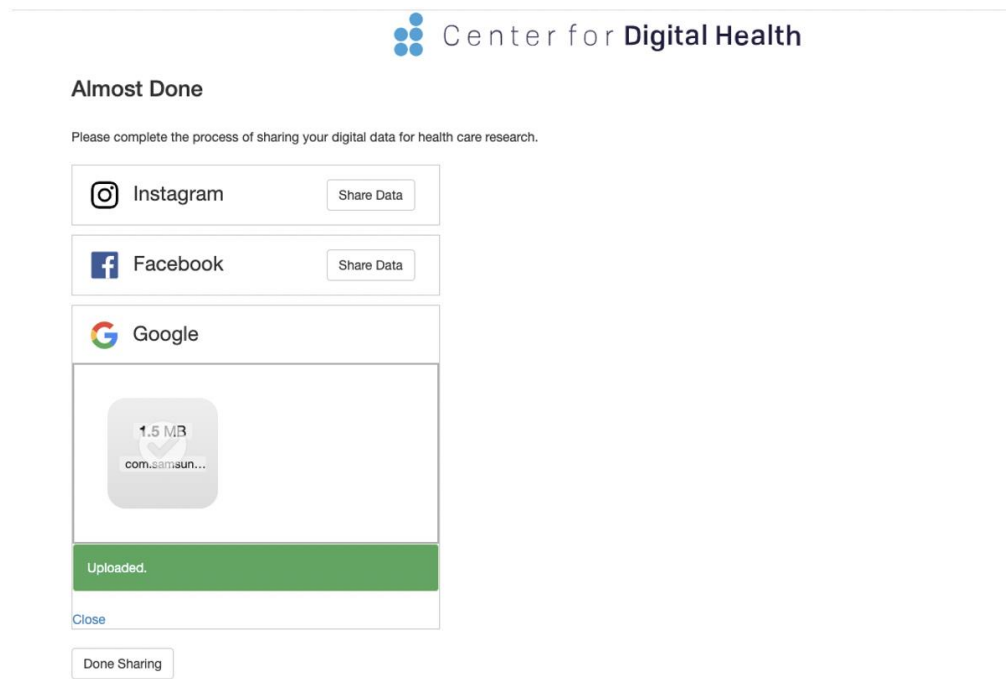
